## PUBLIC NOTICE OF PENDENCY

### Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) Application for Solar Generation License

The Liberia Electricity Regulatory Commission (LERC) hereby notifies the public that an application for a 20-MW Solar Generation License has been filed by the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC) and is pending before the Commission.

The LERC is issuing this Notice of Pendency for Solar Generation License pursuant to Section 13.7 of the 2015 Electricity Law of Liberia and LERC's Administrative Procedure Regulations of September 2020.

1. The main objective of the application is for the applicant, the Liberia Electricity Corporation (LEC), to develop, own and operate a utility-scale solar power facility at Mount Coffee, supporting diversification of the national generation mix, improved system reliability and renewable energy growth in Liberia.
2. A copy of the application is also available for review at the offices of the Liberia Electricity Regulatory Commission (LERC) during working hours between [9:00am to 4:00 pm] within 15 days beginning March 13, 2026, to April 2, 2026, at the following address: LERC Office Location: D-1436 Tubman Boulevard, Adjacent NASSCORP 24th Street, Sinkor, Monrovia, Liberia.
3. Interested parties are invited to submit comments or objections in writing to the Commission or via email ([info@lerc.gov.lr](mailto:info@lerc.gov.lr)).
4. There shall be public hearing on LEC's solar license application in Montserrado County on Friday, April 17, 2026. This public hearing shall commence at 10:00 a.m. on the respective date when LEC shall present its Solar Generation application proposal and interested parties may attend and make oral submissions. The Commission will announce specific venue for the public hearing; and
5. All parties, individuals, Governmental or other legal entities that wish to be formally recognized as parties at the hearing must file a written notification with the Commission to that effect and with a copy submitted to the offices of the Liberia Electricity Corporation.

The Commission is enjoined by law, good regulatory practice and its own philosophy of inclusiveness and transparency to give interveners an opportunity to be heard and would give due consideration to submissions received.
